UltraSil 1113 is a silicone grease prepared from special lithium thickening agent and fortified with polytetrafluoroethylene thickening agent for improved lubricity. This grease is recommended for metal on plastic and plastic on plastic applications. UltraSil 1113 is thermally stable and has superior low temperature properties with excellent thermo-oxidative stability. Like other silicone lubricants, it is compatible with most plastics and elastomers.
